Also on that day The Star Fire Family Show from Fremont, WI. will be performing from 7:00-11:00 P.M. This is an interesting family group that will provide excellent entertainment for you.
5. June 9, 2012, it will be the Julida Boys w/ Allen Bates from West Bend, WI. They will be playing great music from 1:30-5:30.
