## **Resolution 5091-2017 (Approve 2016 Deficit Reduction Fund Transfers).**

Motion by Ald. Schmidt, second by Ald. Smith to approve resolution 5091-2017 regarding the 2016 Deficit Reduction Fund Transfers. Motion carried unanimously.

### Reconvene into Open Session with Possible Action.

Motion by Ald. Toellner, second by Ald. Schmidt to reconvene into Open Session at 9:24 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Ald. Smith, second by Ald. Frings to approve agreement with the Leroy/Kekoskee Water Commission as stated. Motion approved 6-0.

There was discussion on how to allocate the funds whether it be to the general fund or the Water/Wastewater department. The Water Commission has incurred approximately \$1,500 worth of attorney fees since November. Ald. Toellner believes it should all go to the sewer department. Lois advised to consider the financial condition of the sewer utility. The auditor said it could be put in either account, but advised the sewer. The Mayor believes that \$1,500 should go to the sewer and the balance to the general fund as this is money he negotiated for and the sewer department didn't want to pursue. Motion by Ald. Schmidt, second by Ald. Olson that \$1,500 should go to the Water/Wastewater department and the balance should go to the General Fund. Motion carried 5-1 (Ald. Toellner voted no)
