

Minutes for Semi-annual Meeting of the Mayville Golf Course.

May 17, 2017

Meeting called to order by President Jon Jacobs at 6 PM.

There were 33 members, including the MGC Board in attendance.

Jon introduced the Board and new Club House General Manager, Mike Erwin to the membership.

Mike discussed his background in managing various golf courses

The floor was open to suggestions and discussion on improvements that the membership thought would enhance operations. Board member Gene Herman went through a list of projects (attached) that he thought were necessary to improve the course conditions.

Suggestions from the membership included:

- replace sand bunkers on #9 by green with grass traps.
- get ideas on fixing the hill to the back of #9 green.
- make fairway yard markers more visible.
- replace flags on practice green.
- have additional ladies tees.
- make sure water coolers are cleaned.
- re-establish jr. golf program.
- paint (clean up) locker rooms.
- check to see if dumpsters can be moved.
- have staff uniform top for bar & waitresses.
- take unused vending out.
- make sure golf carts are cleaned more often.

Gene Herman went on to especially thank Marc Trott for the donation of signs. Tony Smith from Mayville White Limestone for the donation of stone for the cart paths. Mike Kurutz, Jack Hurst and city employees for their assistance in course maintenance.

Jon thanked everyone for their ideas. Meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.

2017 Mayville project vision

1. Insulate main garage by club house no heat / lots of break downs
2. Fix drainage problem on fairway 1/across through fairway 9 to pond on 10
3. Fix water problem by gold tees on whole 2
4. Dig out ditch between fairways 2 and 6, install culvert for carts to cross
5. Dig ditch out by fairways 4 and 5
6. Install electric pump in pond by fairway 5, cut down on noise and maintenance
7. Fix drainage problem on east side of hill by the green on whole 6
8. Combine some of the sand traps on fairway 9 / night mare to maintain
9. In the process of fixing up shed by the river by hole 12 / roof caving in
10. Eliminate willows, dig a ditch between 15 and 16, and or dig a pond
Too help with drainage on 15, 16, and 17
11. Weather permitting, bringing in tons of sand for the sand traps

Some projects are still in discussion, some are awaiting D N R approval.

Projects are subject to cost and availability, also other projects may arise
