1.) Call to Order and Roll Call.

Meeting called to order at 5:00PM

Members Present: Bob Smith, Rob Boelk, Dolores Neumeyer, and Merlin Kahlhamer.

2.) Approve Agenda.

Motion by Smith, second by Kahlhamer to approve agenda. Motion carried 4-0.

3.) Citizen Comments

4.) Approve the Minutes of the April 27, 2016, meeting.

Motion by Neumeyer, second by Smith to approve minutes of the April 27, 2016 meeting. Motion carried 4-0.

5.) Discussion with possible action on removal of sidewalk along Lina Street.

Don Neitzel stated that Duwayne Crist of 939 Lina Street requested removal of the sidewalk in front of his house along Lina Street. Neitzel stated that the sidewalk is in poor condition and a possible option could be to remove the sidewalk, then replace it when Lina Street is reconstructed in the future. Kahlhamer stated the sidewalk should be repaired. Neumeyer stated the goal should be to have sidewalks everywhere. Smith stated that a policy should be created to determine sidewalk locations and it should be included as part of a 30-year plan. He also mentioned that 45% of the city does not have sidewalk based on a study done years ago. Neitzel mentioned that if one property owner were allowed to remove the sidewalk on their property and a neighbor did not, gaps would be created for pedestrians that use the sidewalk.

Motion by Kahlhamer, second by Neumeyer to recommend against removal of the sidewalk along Lina Street. Motion carried 4-0.

6.) Discussion of Next Meeting Date with Possible Action.

Nathan Kempke stated that at the last Planning Commission meeting there was mention about the possibility of changing the start time of the meetings from 5:00 p.m.

Motion by Kahlhamer, second by Neumeyer to recommend keeping the start time of the Planning Commission meetings at 5:00 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.
