Item #4 – Monthly Fire Department Report.

A. Fire Department Incidents to Date.

Roger Williams distributed a report showing the 2011 incidents to date. Roger noted the dangers of static electricity when leaving a vehicle running while fueling and staying in a vehicle while fueling. He also noted to watch the pump when fueling so that it does not overflow.

B. Carbon Monoxide Incidents State Wide.

Roger Williams reported that there were 9 carbon monoxide calls in the City of Mayville. He also reported that there were 61,100 carbon monoxide incidents nationwide. He noted not to ignore the alarms.

A. Booze and Belts Campaign.

B. Department Statistics.

As of November 30, 2011, there were 3,527 calls of service. This is 9.3% increase over last year at this time. There have been 8,536 reports transcribed by the administrative assistants as of November 30, 2011. There are about 20 open cases. There have been over 1,400 contacts at the window and 4,610 phone calls as of November 30, 2011.

A. Tornado Siren Update.

Chris MacNeill reported that poles have been installed and will hopefully be settled in the ground by Spring.

B. Report on Emergency Management Manual Updates.
