IV. CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- A. Hwy 28/67 DOT Construction Project/Discussion
 - 1. Ron informed the Commission that Kunkel Engineering was awarded the engineering contract for the project by the Common Council, for a total of not to exceed \$124,100.

V. 5-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM/DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

A. Motion by Toellner, seconded by Bushke, to add engineering services expense for the Hwy 28/67 projects to the 5-Year Capital Improvement Program as follows: 2014 - \$33,500 water \$40,600 wastewater and 2018 \$20,700 water and \$29,300 wastewater. The amount of engineering remaining unspent after 2014 to be placed in the following year's capital improvement list. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. SANITARY SEWER LATERAL REPLACEMENT/DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

- A. After lengthy discussion it was decided to come up with three options to deal with the expense of lateral replacement for the following meeting. Possible options were as follows:
 - 1. A \$30 annual fee to all homes to pay for lateral repair/replacement
 - 2. Lateral insurance program
 - 3. Ron's proposed plan, a lien placed on the property to be paid with a small increments on the utilities bill until paid in full, with the remaining balance to be paid at the time of sale of the property.
 - 4. Homeowner financing the entire amount.
