- A. Wells
 - 1. Well #5 The well has been reassembled pumped to waste and one bacti sample has been taken. If all goes well, the well should be back on line next week. The variable speed drive has been ordered and will

be installed when it arrives.

2. Well #3 radium, we have not yet received the latest test result.

B. Towers

Dixon Engineering will be performing the tower inspection on 5/5/10, and will be installing lights on the standpipe.
