<u>Appeal of the Denial of Christopher Rohde Request to Reside at 130 North School Street, 251-1216-2314-044.</u>

The City Clerk Read the Appeal. The Chief of Police, Chris MacNeill, noted that it is his responsibility to keep the residents safe and to enforce the ordinance. He continued that Mr. Rohde had befriended a fourteen year old girl and sexually assaulted her. Mr. Rohde did not take early release. The severity of the incident was noted. The location of the library to the property was noted. The Chief noted that he is seeking for Christopher Rohde's request to reside at 130 North School Street to be denied.

Sherry Scott came to the podium. She noted the steady stream of people that come to that residence/apartment. She noted the alcohol that she sees there and that the area is frequented by children. She continued that she sees the police department there on a regular, daily/weekly basis.

Cheryl Rock came to the podium. She noted the location and that it is close to the library. She consistently sees children in that area and would not feel comfortable with him living there.

Roger Beck came to the podium. He commented that we have the ordinance and it should be followed.
