# Item # 4 Clerk's Report.

A. Update on 2012 Elections.

The City Clerk reported that all incumbents have turned in the required paperwork for the offices that they currently hold. Jerry Moede for Mayor; Kathy Sertich for 2<sup>nd</sup> ward alderperson and Bob Redeker for 4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> ward alderperson; Dave Pasbrig for 6<sup>th</sup> ward alderperson.

In addition, the Spring Election will be on April 3, 2012, and the Organizational Meeting will be on April 17, 2012.

The April 3, 2012, Spring Election will be the first election in the City of Mayville since the election laws have changed. In order to receive a ballot, voters will need to show Photo ID. The photo needs to resemble the voter. And the name needs to conform to the name in the poll book.

The Mayor questioned what types of Photo ID are acceptable. The Clerk read the specific types such as: the WI Driver License, WI State ID, US Passport, WI Driver License Receipt, Armed Forces ID Card, Student ID, and a Tribal ID Card.

Also, voters will be required to sign the poll book.

Absentee voting has also changed in that absentee voting in the clerk's office is now restricted to the two weeks prior to an election and ends the Friday before the election.

Also, the new law prohibits absentee voting and voter registration the Monday before the election. As always voters can register at the polls.

Voters will need to allow extra time at the polls for signing of the poll book and the Photo ID.

Currently, there are 2,837 registered voters in the City of Mayville.
