A. Elections – 2010 Primary and Spring Elections.

The Clerk reported that there will be a Primary Election on February 16, 2010. This will be for Ward 1 and Court of Appeals Judge, District 4. The Spring Election will be on April 6, 2010. Wards up for election are Wards 1, 2, 4&7 and 6. The Mayor is also up for election. Ward one is a one year term.

Ward 1 Primary has J. Trevor Jones, Scott Mastalish, and Tom Bellino in the running; the two with the most votes from the Primary will go on to the Spring Election. For the Spring Election Robert Smith and Jerry Moede are running for Mayor, Ward 2 has Kathy Sertich and Robert Smith, Wards 4 & 7 have Bill Linzenmeyer and Robert Redeker, the incumbent, David Pasbrig, for Ward 6 is running unopposed.

There are possibly four elections this year. If you are not a registered voter, come to City Hall to be registered. You can also register on election day. If you have moved or have had a name change since you last voted you will need to fill out a new registration form which can be done at City Hall.
