Carla Dunn stated the building colors would vary from the pictures included in the packets. The building is planned to be gray with burgundy doors, to match the nearby storage units. The landscaping plan was briefly discussed. Commissioner Puls mentioned there may be an issue with the Evergreen trees planted on the west side of buildings and also suggested using more varieties of plants to avoid a situation where all plants die off if one particular type of plant dies off.
