Staffing Update

They are at full staff for the first time since March. Jeremy Johnson is on his own at nights. They are still 2 part-timers short, but they will wait until late this year or early next year to hire for those.

OTHER ITEMS OF DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

Discuss with Possible Action Ordinance 312-10 Water Traffic, Boating and Water Sports on Rock River

There had been a complaint of a jet ski above the lower dam. At first they believed it was against the ordinance to operate that. There is a provision for no-wake from the foot bridge to the upper dam, but doesn't specify upper dam to lower dam. A simple solution would be to change "upper" to "lower". The Police Department would recommend it for safety. Ald. Smith noted with the free kayaks it would be a good idea. It was also noted that the water way is only 75 ft wide so to make high speed turns it could be difficult. They believe it was mis-wording in the ordinance at the time.
