Merlin Kahlmer asked if this would be a business. Mr. Hilbert replied that it would not be a business and that he is not looking to work on vehicles at this location either. He stated that this would just be for storage of the vehicles.

John Gable asked if this has been discussed with the neighbors. Mr. Hilbert replied that he has not spoken with any of them yet about this.

Travis Puls stated that his biggest concern is stormwater drainage from the proposed building and site once developed, and how it might impact neighboring properties causing issues that they have not had in the past. He also stated that he thought it would be good for Mr. Hilbert to discuss this with the adjacent neighbors to the east and west of this parcel.

Mr. Hilbert stated that he would not be looking to construct this for a couple of years. He directed not to submit anything until he was ready to move forward with the project.
