The League is working on opportunities for downtown.

## Discuss with Possible Action Food Court/Entertainment Area on Allen Street

Continued discussion on Allen Street. Melissa has talked to John Wild and is going to chat with the police chief. They also need to get a hold of DOT. Melissa has come up with more ideas and is working on budget. She noted that ideally they will need 2 motions. One to close the street and to take it to council and the 2nd is to apply for the grant from AARP. The Mayor noted he spoke to Felix and Ming. Ming was hesitant due to covid. Felix just wanted to make sure the space is open in the back. They did not want food tents down there or it affects his business. John viewed it as a new park. They discussed barricades/planters. Just to close the road, get tables, garbage cans, etc it will be approximately \$5,000. If they are looking at a stage, etc it could go up to \$20,000. There was discussion on using it year round or just partially. Dawn spoke with Main Street Mayville and they liked the idea. The Mayor suggested it be open June, July & August. Melissa noted if the street isn't closed through December they won't be eligible for the grant. The grant needs to show multiple seasons and tie in local businesses. They will put it on the Council agenda for 4/12 to close the street. Discussion on dates.
