Training Update

They try to be patient advocates. A lot of people didn't go to the hospitals last year because of COVID, so they so much sicker patients.

Equipment Update

The mechanic was here last week to start on repairs. They are doing pump and hose testing in June. The ladder truck is back up and running.

Staffing Update

Improving each month. They have 22 at this point. They can bring up to 25 firefighters. They are hosting the Fire Chief's association tomorrow night. Ald. Frings questioned if they'd be doing national night out. The PD plans on having it.

Fire Call Update

They have 41 calls year to date. This is the 2nd busiest year they've ever had.
