Water Distribution System Update

- As of 5/17/2021. We 31 lead service replacements complete. Through inspections we have narrowed the total number of lead services down from 248 to 223. All of Bridge St is being inspected for unknown lead services during construction.
- Hydro-Corp has completed its first round of cross connection inspections for commercial properties. Residential properties will be inspected as well.
- Well #4 is out of service due to an iron filter from 1966 that is beyond repair.

Wastewater Treatment Plan Operations Update

- Cured in place pipe lining has been completed on Muzzy St. This line had large holes in it. Riverview Heights will be completed next due to root issues.
- 12 manhole covers with pick holes have been replaced with tight sealing lids and one manhole raised by staff to help with inflow and infiltration issues.

There was discussion on the issues with the paving projects. They are holding off waiting for Willow Circle Quotes. There is a 2nd crew moving in on Friday to start on Tuesday on Bridge STreet.
