MAYVILLE CITY TAX PAYERS

City Hall will be closed on December 23, 26 & 30, 2022 and January 2, 2023

FIRST INSTALLMENT or **PAYMENT IN FULL** (due by Tuesday, January 31, 2023):

Mail in payment (City of Mayville, PO Box 273, Mayville, WI 53050)

If mailing escrow check, remember to sign check.

If receipt is needed, a stamped, self-addressed envelope is required.

If post marked by 2022, but received in 2023, it will be noted on receipt.

All payments must be post marked by 01/31/23 to be considered on time.

Drop in drop box. (Silver box in parking lot of City Hall)

If dropping escrow check, remember to sign check.

If receipt is needed, a stamped, self-addressed envelope is required.

If placed in drop box before Midnight 12/31/22, will be noted received in 2022.

Payment in person at City Hall.

Open Monday- Friday 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m.

City Hall will be closed on December 23, 26 & 30, 2022 and January 2, 2023.

City hall accepts credit cards for payment with an added convenience fee per PSN.

HOW YOU QUALIFY FOR CREDITS:

Lottery Credit

You are eligible if you lived in your home as your primary residence as of January 1, 2022.

First Dollar Credit

Every taxable parcel (business, commercial or private) containing a real property improvement (ex: building), qualifies for the First Dollar Credit.

Unlike the Lottery and Gaming Credit, the property does not have to be the owner's primary residence.

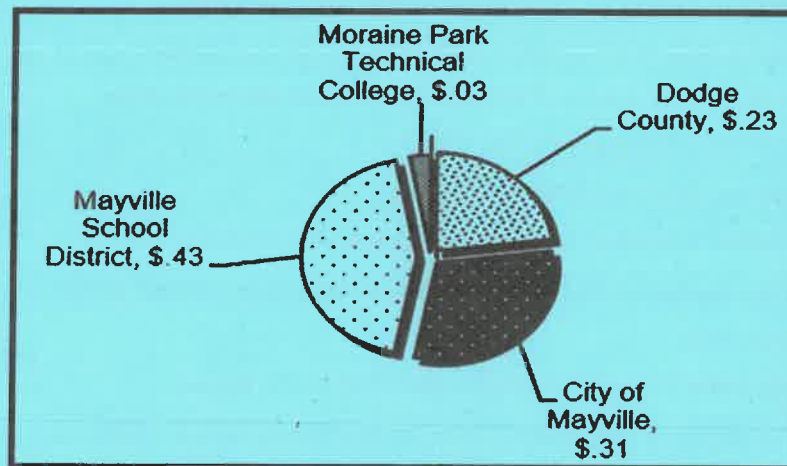

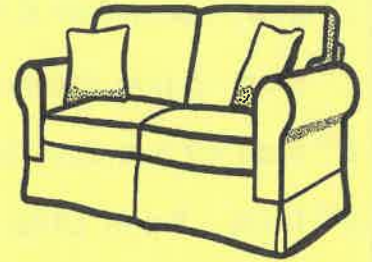

start of falling leaves to freezing temperatures.
It takes two weeks to get from one side of town to the other.

Residents can take leaves to the
DPW City Garage compost pile year-round.

Per ordinance 368-4 Snow & ice removal:
Property owners shall be responsible
for the removal of snow and ice at all
public sidewalks within 24 hours after
snow ceases or be subject to added
costs for the City to remove it.

Chloride Reduction

Freshwater organisms can't tolerate high levels of chlorides (salt). Water softening systems, industrial sources and winter ice control contribute to high concentrations entering treatment facilities.

"It only cost 20 cents to add a pound of salt to water, but five dollars to remove it."

Small yet helpful steps to reduce salt in the water:

- ◆ Water softener settings reduces salt use by 27%. Service professionals can help with settings.
- ◆ Replace old inefficient softeners reduces salt use by 48%. Usage based models are the best choice.

- **Snow event:** No vehicles parked on the streets from 1 am—6 am when snowplows are used to clear the roads.
- **Snow emergency:** No vehicles parked on public streets or alleys from start of snow emergency until streets are cleared.
- Vehicles parked on the roadway during a snow event/emergency will be issued a parking ticket.
- Vehicle may be ordered to be towed from the street at the owner's expense.
- Parking permits are available at City Hall for municipal parking lots.
