MAYVILLE CITY TAX PAYERS

City Hall will be closed on December 23, 26 & 30, 2022 and January 2, 2023

FIRST INSTALLMENT or PAYMENT IN FULL (due by Tuesday, January 31, 2023):

Mail in payment (City of Mayville, PO Box 273, Mayville, WI 53050)

If mailing escrow check, remember to sign check.

If receipt is needed, a stamped, self-addressed envelope is required.

If post marked by 2022, but received in 2023, it will be noted on receipt.

All payments must be post marked by 01/31/23 to be considered on time.

Drop in drop box. (Silver box in parking lot of City Hall)

If dropping escrow check, remember to sign check.

If receipt is needed, a stamped, self-addressed envelope is required.

If placed in drop box before Midnight 12/31/22, will be noted received in 2022.

Payment in person at City Hall.

Open Monday- Friday 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m.

City Hall will be closed on December 23, 26 & 30, 2022 and January 2, 2023.

HOW YOU QUALIFY FOR CREDITS:

Lottery Credit

You are eligible if you lived in your home as your primary residence as of January 1, 2022.

If you do not currently receive a lottery credit on your tax bill, contact the City Treasurer at 920-387-7900 x1207.

First Dollar Credit

Every taxable parcel (business, commercial or private) containing a real property improvement (ex: building), qualifies for the First Dollar Credit.

Unlike the Lottery and Gaming Credit, the property does not have to be the owner's primary residence.



Chloride Reduction

- Water softener settings reduces salt use by 27%.
 Service professionals can help with settings.
- Replace old inefficient softeners reduces salt use by 48%. Usage based models are the best choice.

- Snow event: No vehicles parked on the streets from 1 am—6 am when snowplows are used to clear the roads.
- Snow emergency: No vehicles parked on public streets or alleys from start of snow emergency until streets are cleared.
- Vehicles parked on the roadway during a snow event/emergency will be issued a parking ticket.
- Vehicle may be ordered to be towed from the street at the owner's expense.
- Parking permits are available at City Hall for municipal parking lots.
