CONSENT AGENDA

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING CONTRACTS WITH SUEZ/VEOLIA FOR WELL AND IRON FILTER MAINTENANCE.

Discussion held regarding contract renewal with Veolia. Future rehabilitation will negate this need.

WATER REPORT

On 10/5/23 we had a main break on Allen St right next to an existing band.

Well 4 split face block is being installed. Windows, doors and HVAC will be installed next week. The iron filtration tank will be delayed until April.

Cathodic protection for the towers was inspected and passed today.

Fall hydrant flushing is complete.

Alley St and Metalcraft are paved and landscaping work is being done as of today.

Town & Country discovered a lead service at a residence. They were contracted for a sewer replacement and found lead underground. This was one we previously had checked and had copper coming through the floor.

WASTEWATER REPORT

Permit reissuance is due by 4/4/2024. Our sampling kit has been sent to the lab and permit documents about a quarter complete.

Whole effluent toxicity testing passed for October. We test 2nd and 3rd quarter next year per our permit.

Surveyors and MSA staff spent the day with us on 10/31 locating and verifying current sewer plant details and specs. We are working on northern property access as well for future sludge hauling.

As a Village Trustee of Brownsville, we have slowly been ramping up what we are trying to do and I feel it hasn't worked. All you can do is figure out how much of a carrot you are willing to offer to get some changes. This is why I'm making myself available for free to any Mayville resident to have their system at least looked at and then I'm happy to match what Mayville is offering to get more efficient equipment in these homes to help reduce Chlorides.

In the end, people don't really care unless the Chloride issue begins to cost them money that they can directly relate to the problem, until then, you can only hope that a few hundred dollars is enough for them to spend \$1,000 or more to get a better softener. I'll do my best to educate on their salt savings, the money from the city, and the discount from Culligan and if the savings is enough, then maybe they say "Yes."

INSPECTION:

On Monday, November 20, 2023 James Orr Coating Inspection performed a pro bono inspection on the tank exterior coatings.

TANK INFORMATION:

The Sphere was built in 1976 by Chicago Bridge and Iron, Oakbrook, IL. The capacity listed on the tank plate is 500,000 gallons. The height to the bottom of the bowl is 140'-6".

COATING THICKNESS: Mil readings were taken on the exterior base cone. The coating thicknesses average 8.5 mils DFT. The coating thickness is a normal thickness and should easily support an overcoat.

ADHESION: An adhesion test was performed using an X-cut adhesion on the clear coat to the under coats. The adhesion was very good and should support an overcoat.

LEAD PAINT: A lead paint test was conducted on the exterior coating. There is no lead paint in the existing exterior coatings.

SEVEN BROTHERS PAINTING: Inspector had a discussion with Sam Vushaj, Seven Brothers Tank Painting regarding the Mayville Tank. After explaining the condition of the exterior coating to Sam he felt very confident that his company could successfully perform and exterior overcoat the tank along with a 5 year warranty
